In order to prepare you for this content, and as an example of what you can expect in the coming school year, you are expected to complete this assignment prior to the first day of school.

### Step 1

Join the Google Classroom for our class by going to [classroom.google.com](https://classroom.google.com) (or the Google Classroom app) and clicking the '+' or 'Join' button. Use the code: **uqmu6h** to join. Be sure to sign up using your Aledo Google account ([firstname.lastname@g.aledoisd.org](mailto:firstname.lastname@g.aledoisd.org)). If you do not have one or are new to the district, you may use whatever account you wish, but plan on switching to the Aledo one early in the year.

You also may want to join our Remind messages by using the Remind app or texting '@sheddgeo' to 81010.

### Step 2

You will see in Google Classroom the assignment #001 Summer Assignment. Attached, you'll find an introduction video for myself and for the topics you'll be working with on this summer assignment. Watch this video for a primer on the topic.

### Step 3

You will also see attached a Google Slides file titled #001 Summer Assignment. This Slides contains your assignment. **Open it, click File > Make a Copy...** and you will have your own copy that you can edit to complete the assignment.

### Step 4

When you've completed the Slides, be sure to bring it, ready to discuss and evaluate, on the first day of school. You should also submit it to the assignment on Google Classroom whenever you complete it. Do this by Opening the assignment, Adding the Slides file, and then Turning In the assignment.
