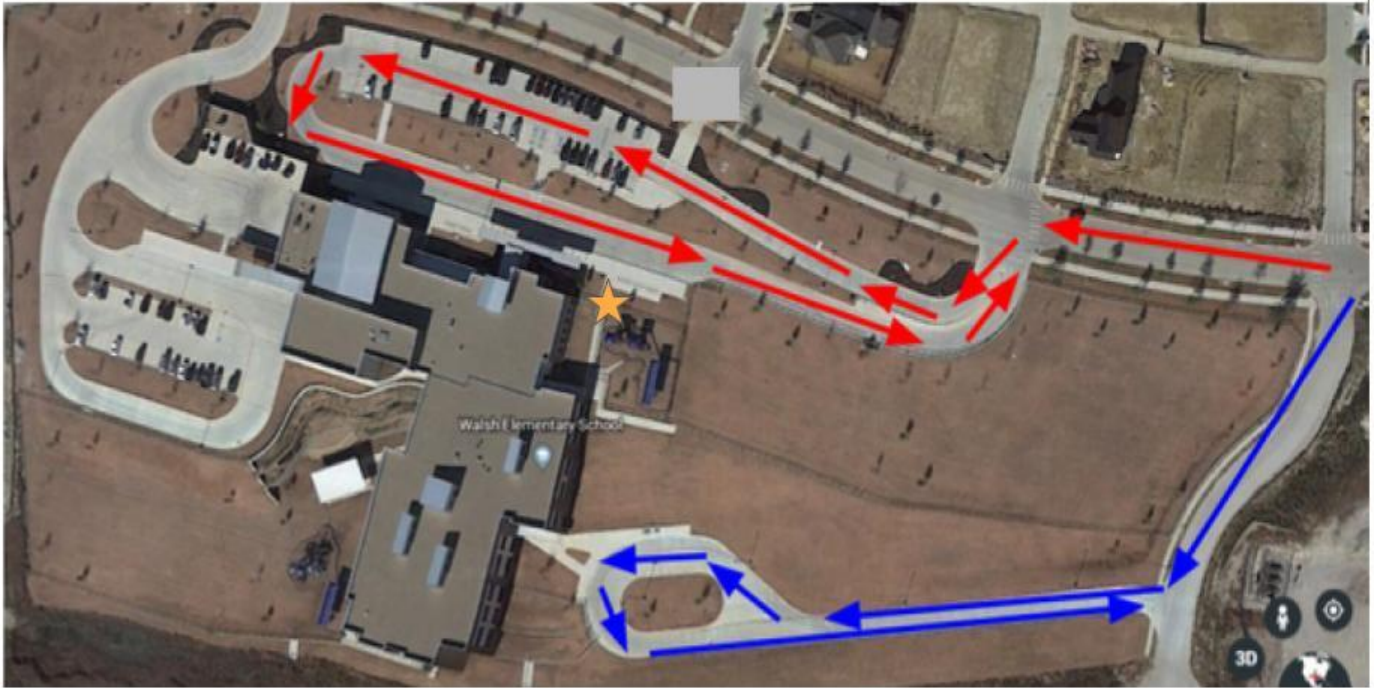

The orange star will indicate where walkers are released (please ensure guardians are crossing back over the crosswalk with their children from walker pick-up location)



Drop and Off and Pick Up

To ensure the utmost safety for our staff and students, please know that all students will need to exit their vehicle from the **RIGHT** side.

Student Drop Off

Please keep the following key items in mind on your child's first day of school:

- For students who are able to exit the vehicle independently, please drop off at our lower loop - This is preferable for 3rd - 5th grade students who are familiar with our building.
- For students needing assistance getting out of the vehicle (we will open the door and minimally assist with exiting), please drop off at our main entrance.

- All students will go straight to their classroom upon arrival unless they are eating breakfast. Students eating breakfast will move straight to the cafeteria and head to the classroom once finished.
- Parents will not be permitted in the building aside from the 1st day of school.
- Please know that we will have multiple staff members stationed throughout the building to ensure every student feels welcomed and is able to reach their classroom safely.

Student Dismissal/Parent Pick Up

We are excited to be rolling out a new dismissal system that we feel will expedite the process. All students will be dismissed from their classroom, rather than from the hallway, as has been previously done. We will be using CurbSmart to assist our dismissal. Teachers will be communicating the information you will need for your child's first day. On the first day, a car tag (or a few) will be sent home. The system is based on a number and each family will have one number for all of their children that attend Walsh. When we put the number in the app, it will alert each classroom teacher of the student's name and they will make their way to the appropriate exit.

Please note the following:

- K-2 will dismiss from upstairs (front of school) - Older siblings will also come upstairs to exit when their number is called.
- 3-5 will dismiss from the downstairs loop.
- Afternoon Walkers - if you would like your child to be a walker in the afternoon, you will need to clearly communicate that to your child's teacher.

Unaccompanied Walkers: (those who are able to walk home on their own or with an older sibling), will be dismissed from the side doors, closest to the upstairs playground.

Walk-Ups: For younger students (K-2) whose parents/ guardians are walking up to meet them, may pick them up outside the playground gate, forming a line on the sidewalk.

All guardians walking up to pick up their children will need their car pick-up tags to check-in and pick up their children. This ensures the safety of students and the appropriate release of our walkers.

Once your child has been released, please escort them back across the designated crosswalk and off of campus grounds.
