Lesson Delivery (What do we want you to learn?):

The goal is to learn and use vocabulary and sentences about activities done around the house



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Engage and Practice (What do we want you to do?):

Watch the vocabulary Video "HOME ACTIVITIES" IN GOOGLE CLASSROOM. Then watch 2 more times while practicing along with it.

Fingerspelling see it and sign it. Look in Google classroom in Materials for the HOME ACTIVITIES fingerspelling video. I will Fingerspell vocabulary words, I want you to sign them when you see it. Don't record this, it is a practice activity.

Create and Submit (What do we want you to turn in?):

Make a video of you responding to a friend using a videophone who asked you to help with chores around the house. Using the listing technique tell them 4 chores that you would be willing to help with, and 5 chores you wouldn't help them with. Then tell them what your favorite thing on the list is to do. Record this and upload to google classroom.

Optional Extension Opportunity (What do we want you to do if you want to extend your learning?):

Explain what you don't like about three of the chores and add it to your video.
