Optional Extension Opportunity (What do we want you to do if you want to extend your learning?):

The Houston Rodeo starts in just 17 minutes and all of the singers' members must all cross a bridge to get there. The four singers begin on the same side of the bridge and you must help them to get across to the other side.

Due to the age of the bridge, a maximum of two people can cross at one time. To make matters worse, it is night-time and there is only one torch. The torch is always required when crossing the bridge and the torch must be walked back and forth; it cannot be thrown, etc. Each singer walks at a different speed and a pair must walk together at the rate of the slower person:

Usher takes 1 minute to cross

Luke Bryan takes 2 minutes to cross

Adam Levine takes 5 minutes to cross

Hunter Hayes takes 10 minutes to cross

For example, if Usher and Hunter walk across first, it takes them 10 minutes to cross. If Adam then returns with the torch, a total of 15 minutes will have passed. There is no trick behind this, it is the simple movement of resources in the appropriate order.
