GPA and Class Rank

Aledo High School students earn a grade point average and class rank based on their academic achievement. Grade point average and class rank, for the Class of 2023, is outlined below.

Calculation

Grade point averages are calculated at the end of each semester by taking the sum of all grades and dividing that sum by the total number of credits or courses taken. Courses that are given additional weight, and courses that are excluded in a student's grade point average, are outlined below.

Weighted Grade System

Aledo High School uses a weighted grade system to calculate GPA. For students in the class of 2023, Advanced Courses earn a 10% weight of the semester average when calculated into GPA; AP courses earn a 15% weight of the semester average when calculated into GPA. The actual grade appears on the transcript. The weight is figured into the grade point average.

Exclusions

The following course types are not calculated into GPA: *athletics/PE; any PE Substitutions including marching band, drill team, and cheerleading; credit recovery courses; credit by examination (with or without prior instruction); local credit courses; courses taken through the Texas Virtual School Network (TxVSN); distance learning (traditional correspondence courses).*

Class of 2023 GPA Breakdown

Class rank is a measure of how a student's academic performance compares to other students in their graduating class. As a reference, the lowest grade point average with each recognized category is outlined below for the Class of 2023.

Top 6%	102.29666
Top 10%	100.87000
Top 25%	97.16428
Top 50%	91.90625
Top 75%	84.95333
