

What is a Bond Election?

- A school district is required by law to hold an election and get permission from voters to sell bonds and levy taxes to pay for them
- Bonds are sold to fund capital improvements
- These projects are typically too large to be included in operating budgets

Bond money CAN be used for:

- New Facilities
- Expansion & Renovations
- Furniture
- Technology
- Equipment
- Buses
- Land For Future Facilities



Bond money CANNOT be used for:

- Teacher & Staff Salaries
- Utilities
- Gasoline
- Other Operating Expenses





ALEDO GROWTH COMMITTEE

Similar process to Bearcat Growth Committee from 2019 Bond

- Led & facilitated by volunteer community co-chairs
- 49 community members representing a diversity of demographics and geography, including teachers from across the district
- AGC hosted two community meetings and sent out a communitywide survey to gather feedback
- Aledo ISD students, campus and district staff, outside demographer, financial advisor, and architects served as resources for the AGC
- All presentations provided to the AGC were and are publicly available online
- All AGC meetings open to the public

Timeline of the AGC's Work

Aug 22, 2022

AGC appointed by AISD Board of Trustees and given charge for work

Dec 6&8, 2022

AGC hosts 2 public community meetings for feedback

Jan 26-31, 2023

Community feedback survey open to public; AGC reviews survey data

Feb 13, 2023

AGC formally recommends bond package to trustees and presents long-range plan for growth; Board votes to approve AGC's proposal & calls May 6, 2023, bond

Aug 29, 2022

First of 13 AGC meetings (through 2/6); AGC also presented regular updates to AISD Board of Trustees during monthly meetings

Jan 26, 2023

AGC presents draft proposal of immediate needs to Board of Trustees and community

Feb 6, 2023


AGC meeting to discuss community feedback and create a long-range facilities plan; AGC reaches 100% consensus on bond package to present to trustees as well as long-range plan

Moderate Growth Scenario - PASA, AISD Demographer



- Site work, drainage and utility reconfiguration likely required


AHS Renovation Project Highlights:

- Restroom, Library, Lecture Hall, Auditorium, and Cafeteria Serving Line Renovation
- Repurposed space for new changing rooms
- New flooring and paint in classrooms
- New paint and wall finish in hallways

Multi-Purpose Addition Project Highlights:

- Flexible, large spaces for academic and co-curricular programs
- Adds restrooms, locker rooms (plumbing) to facility
- Preserves practice fields




Over 2 Decades of Clean Annual Financial Audits


Yearly Cost of Additional \$0.0250 on Owner of Average-Value Home

\$7.48/monthly cost

School taxes paid by taxpayers over 65 are capped at the amount paid in the year they turned 65 and cannot increase beyond that amount unless they make improvements to their property. Taxpayers must apply for this exemption.

This is an amount for a particular home value. Home values in AISD are expected to increase in value each year, so these amounts will also increase.



What Happens If...

... the 2023 Bond passes?

- AGC's recommended bond projects will be completed
- Elementary attendance zones redrawn for 2024-2025
- ES#7 opens 2024
- Additional flexible program space for the high school level will be open 2025
- AHS/DNG will receive new furniture to complete districtwide furniture replacement
- I&S tax rate increase of 2.5 cents
- Anticipated continued decrease of M&O tax rate

... the 2023 Bond fails?

- M&O funds will be used to purchase 10 portables for 2024-25 (\$2.5 million), 12 portables for 2025-26 (\$3 million)
- Elementary attendance zones redrawn for 2024-2025
- No bond money available for land purchases, buses, technology, maintenance or safety projects
- I&S tax rate does not increase
- Anticipated continued decrease of M&O tax rate



Bond Fast Facts

- Bond package proposal led and created by community members; created to address immediate needs using only two years of property value growth
- Student enrollment is projected to more than double in 7 years
- Maximum capacity projected to be exceeded in 2 years (2024-2025) at 5 of 6 elementary schools
- Provides increased flexible space for growing academic and co-curricular programs at the high-school level
- Permits AISD to plan for growth by purchasing land for future campuses
- Allows AISD to make safety and security improvements, complete facility maintenance, upgrade district technology, and add to/replace part of district bus fleet
- 2.5 cent Interest & Sinking tax rate increase; impact \$89.76/year or \$7.48/month for owner of average-valued AISD home (\$407,049)
- AISD overall tax rate has decreased 22.71 cents the last 4 years; anticipated continued Maintenance
 & Operations tax rate reduction for 2023-24
