FAST-GROWTH

Texas has just over 1,000 public school districts and 68 are considered fast-growth by the Texas Fast Growth School Coalition, including Aledo ISD. According to the most recent demographic report, 1 in 4 current Aledo ISD students has joined the district in the last five years.



CONTINUED GROWTH

Student enrollment in Aledo ISD is projected to more than double in 7 years. Five of Aledo ISD's six elementary schools will exceed maximum capacity by 2024-2025. Projections show that capacity will be exceeded at the middle school level in 2027-2028 and at high school in 2028-2029.

COMMUNITY DESIGNED

- The Aledo Growth Committee (AGC) is 49 community members led and facilitated by volunteer community co-chairs representing a diversity of demographics and geography, including teachers from across the district
- The AGC met 13 times from August 2022 to February with two additional communitywide meetings for feedback
- The AGC came to 100 percent consensus on a bond package presented to Trustees that addresses immediate needs due to Aledo ISD's fast growth
- The AGC also recommended to Trustees a longrange plan for growth (see other side) to provide a roadmap for the district's continued growth

School taxes paid by taxpayers over 65 are capped at the amount paid in the year they turned 65 and cannot increase beyond that amount unless they make improvements to their property. Taxpayers must apply for this exemption. This is an amount for a particular home value. Each year, these amounts will also increase.

Fall 2024 | Elementary No. 7 opens on district-owned property northwest of McAnally MS

January 2025 | All high school addition/repurpose and renovation projects complete

Summer 2025 | AHS furniture delivered; completes districtwide furniture replacement
