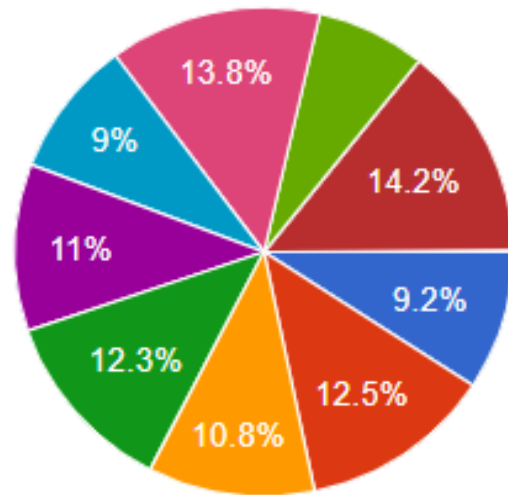

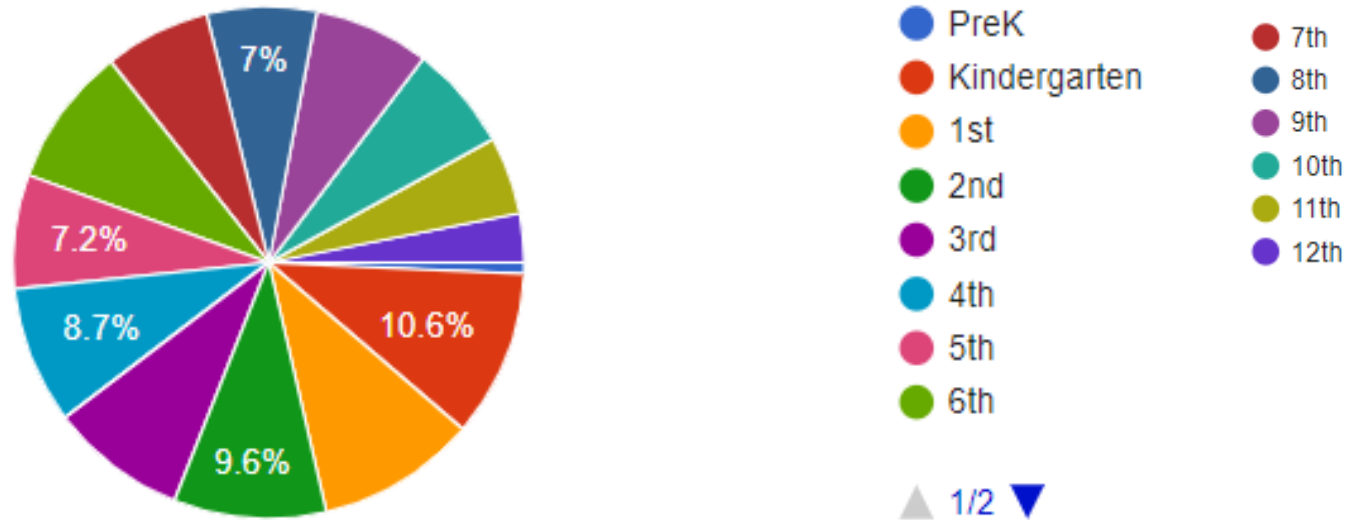

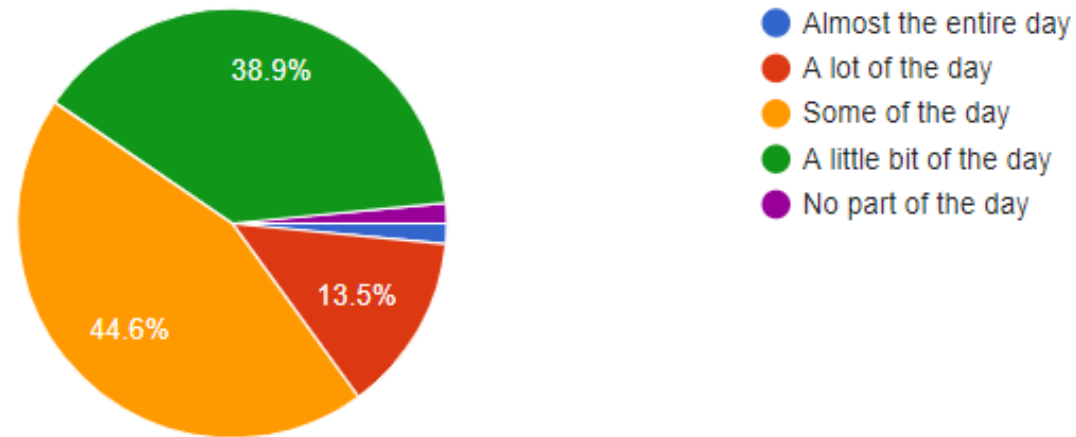




Distance Learning Reflection

How much of the day did your student spend learning or completing schoolwork?

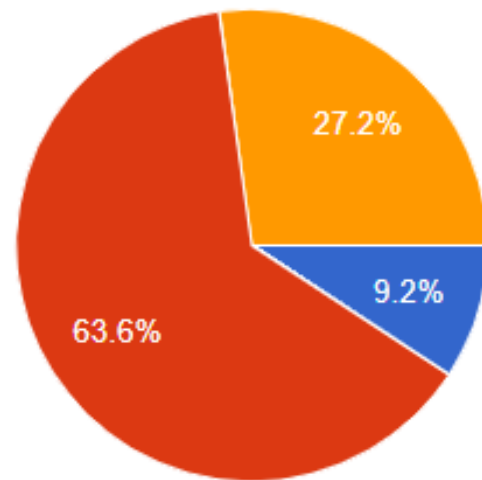

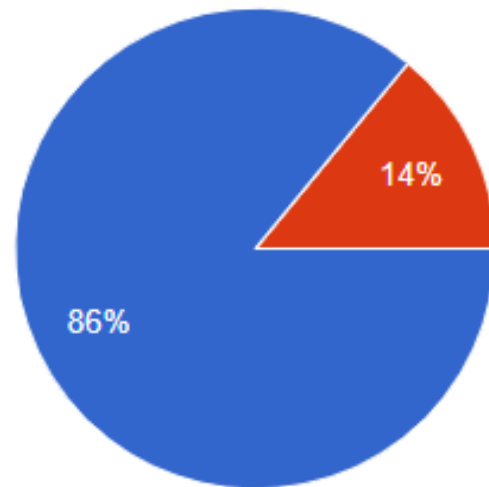

Please rate your level of satisfaction with the social-emotional support that has been available through AISD's counseling department.





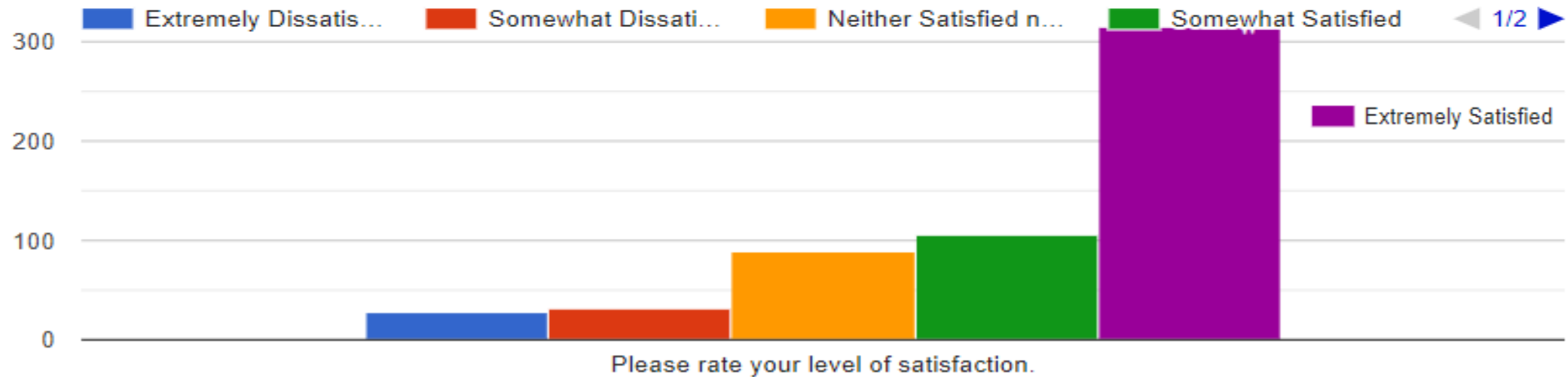

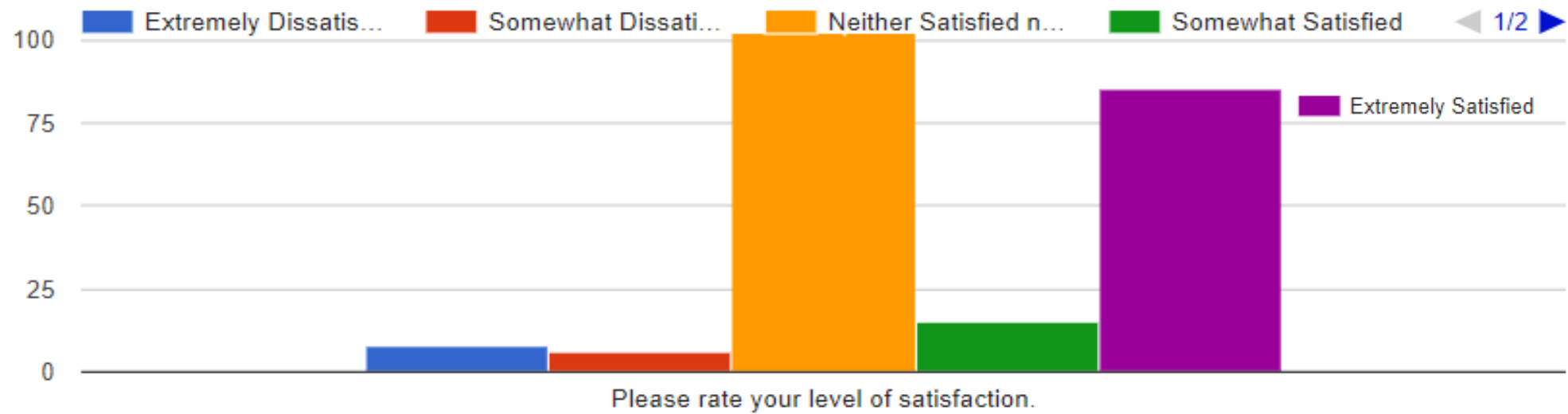

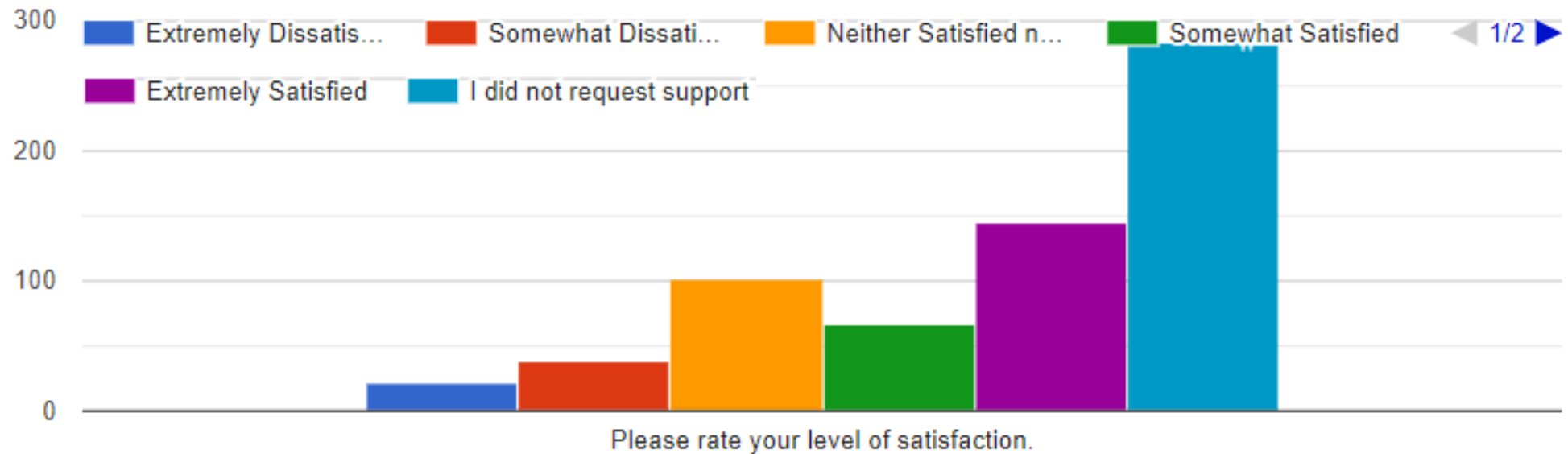


How satisfied were you with the district-provided hotspot? (If your student did not receive a district-provided hotspot, please skip this question and move to the next question.)

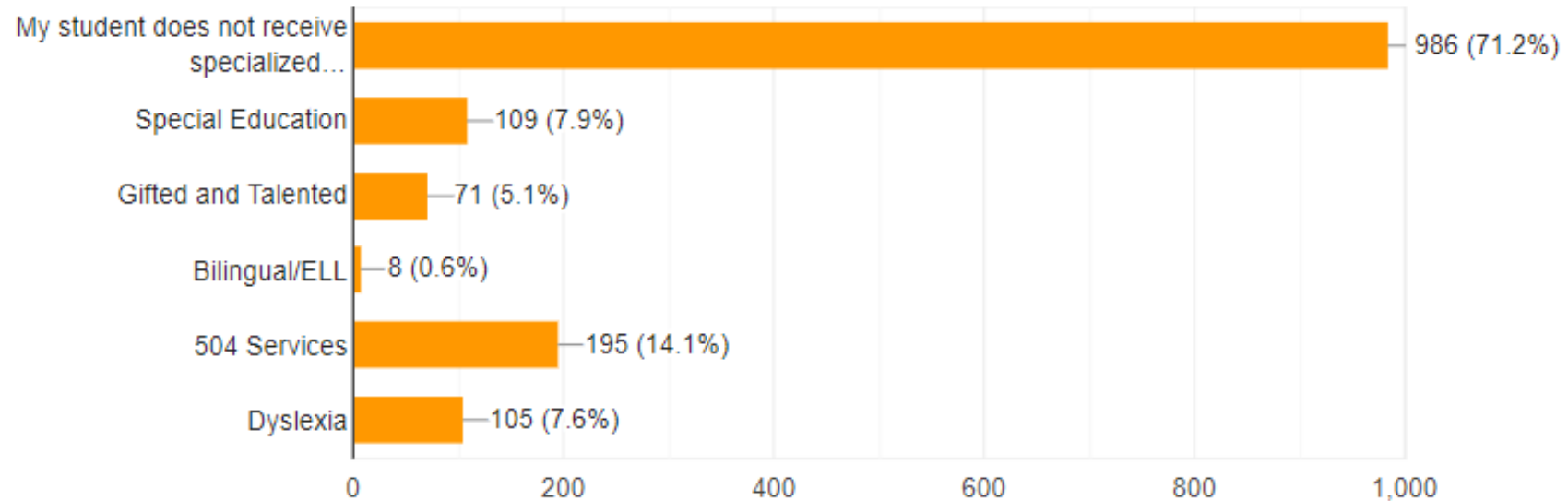

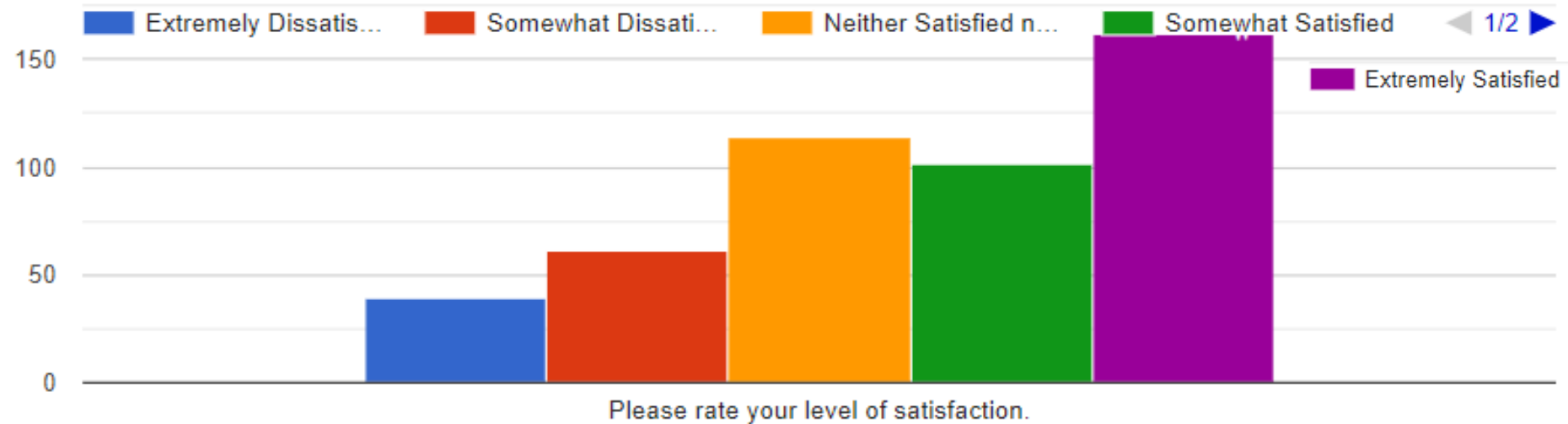
